

From the Desk of the Archbishop You may have a claim against the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. On January 4, 2011, the Archdiocese of Milwaukee (the “Archdiocese”) filed for reorganization under chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Wisconsin, Case No. 11-20059. If you were abused by any clergy member, teacher, deacon, employee, volunteer, or other person connected with the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, you must file a claim by February 1, 2012 at 4 pm Prevailing Central Time).
